DigitalPakt Alter: the network

- Opportunities of digitalisation for the participation of older people.:
 - By expanding the partner network (eleven federal states, partners from business, science, civil society).
 - Through the exchange of knowledge and experience in four thematic semesters and expert conferences.
 - Through "Erfahrungsorte" (places of experience)



DigitalPakt *Alter*: Accesses on site

Creating access to digitalisation for older people:

- 200 "Erfahrungsorte" across Germany and selection of a further 100 of such experience sites by 2025.
- Training, counselling and support for the "Erfahrungsorte", as well as networking with each other and with partner organisations.
- Regional meetings for on-site networking
